- a. The Contractor shall carry or require that there be carried Worker's Compensation Insurance an Employer's Liability Insurance for all his/her employees and those of his/her subcontractors engaged in work at the sites in accordance with Pennsylvania Worker's Compensation Laws.
- b. The Contractor shall carry (or require that there be carried) Commercial General Liability Insurance with combined single limit of \$5,000,000 to protect the Contractor and his/her subcontractors against claims for bodily injury, personal injury and property damage to one or more than one person because of accidents which may occur or result from operations under the Contract; such insurance shall cover the use of all equipment, including but not limited to excavating machinery, trenching machines, cranes, hoists, rollers, concrete mixers and mobile equipment in the construction of the improvement embraced in this Contract.
- c. The Contractor shall carry, during the life of the contract, Automobile Insurance in an amount of not less than \$1,000,000 for each accident covering all owned, non-owned and hired automobiles for protection from claims for property damage and bodily injury which might arise from operations under the Contract.
- d. The Contractor will purchase and maintain completed value (Builder's Risk) property insurance upon the project to the full insurable value thereof. This insurance shall include the interests of the OWNER, the Contractor and Subcontractors in the work and shall insure against all risks of direct physical loss of or damage to insured property, including theft of building materials.
- e. The Contractor shall submit evidence of the coverage required above to the Local Public Agency for review and approval. Proof of this insurance shall be provided by the successful bidder following the bid opening, but before award of the Contract, as a condition of the award. Substitute policies shall be provided in place of those disapproved. All insurance shall be carried with insurance companies with an AM Best Company Rating of B+ or higher, licensed in the State and approved by the Local Public Agency, and shall be kept in force until the Contractor's work is accepted by the Local Public Agency. Contracts of insurance (covering all operations under this Contract), which expire before the Contractor's work is accepted by the Local Public Agency, shall be renewed and evidence of such renewal shall be submitted to the Local Public Agency for its approval.
- f. The successful bidder shall provide Certificate(s) of Insurance following the bid opening, but before the award of the contract, as a condition of the award. The Certificate(s) shall name the County of Washington, Redevelopment Authority of the County of Washington, TranSystems Corporation and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as additional insured.
- g. The Contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless the County of Washington, Redevelopment Authority of the County of Washington, TranSystems Corporation, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, their servants, agents, and employees from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses, including attorney's fees arising out of or resulting from the performance of the services provided that any such claim, damage, loss or expense is attributable and is caused in whole or in part by any negligent act or omission of the Contractor, any Subcontractor, anyone directly or indirectly employed by any of the Contractors or Subcontractors or anyone for whose acts may be liable.
