Washington County Local Shares Account Review Committee Announces \$10M In Recommendations

Washington, PA – Washington County Local Share Account (LSA) Review Committee today approved \$10,025,000 in community, public interest, job training and economic development projects throughout Washington County. The board recommended 67 projects for approval this year, directing funds to local governments, nonprofit organizations, and other eligible entities throughout the county.

Beyond the LSA investment, it will be leveraged by \$68,381,890 in additional funding for an astonishing total of \$78,406,890 in economic impact for Washington County.

LSA Chairman Mark Hrutkay said, “Participating in the LSA process and working with an experienced and an accomplished team made for good decision-making. The goal of helping improve everyday life of Washington County residents through the LSA project grants is very gratifying.”

“From improvements to parks and facilities to upgrades in municipal sewage and classroom environments, these diverse recommendations will enhance our communities by completing and jumpstarting essential projects, Washington County Commissioner Chair Nick Sherman stated.”

“I would like to thank the LSA Committee for their extensive and thoughtful work in approving these important and broad-based projects throughout the entire county. I especially give thanks to Chairman Mark Hrutkay for stepping in at the last minute to fill his critical role. The Board of Commissioners will likely act on this recommendation at our February 4 Public Meeting, Sherman added.”

The Washington County Local Share Account (LSA) has been established to support community and economic development through gaming revenues generated pursuant to the Pennsylvania Racehorse Development and Gaming Act.
