What Goes in the Yellow Security Return Bag After the Polls Are Closed and the Reports Have Been Printed from the DS200 Precinct Scanner?

- Media Stick from DS200 Precinct Scanner - place in clear corner pocket
 - ***If you forget the media stick you will be asked to return to Polling Place to retrieve it***
- Coil Ring with keys
- Envelope containing Election Codes
- Completed Pay Vouchers
- White Provisional Ballot Envelope containing voted Provisional Ballots and unused Provisional Ballot supplies
- Election Return Envelope "A"
- Affirmation of Elector Envelope
- Spoiled Ballot Envelope with spoiled ballot activation cards
- Supplemental paper poll book, if used
- Emergency back-up paper poll book, if used
- Clear tamper evident bag sealed with surrendered absentee and mail in ballots and completed declarations

Attach a security seal to the Yellow Return Security Bag and Return to the Elections Office along with the Blue Ballot Bag on Election Night.
